Instead, log in at [pbkaca.org](http://pbkaca.org), make sure your contact information is current (in particular your email address), click a button to pay your dues through PayPal using your own credit card, and receive a receipt within seconds. If you had an active membership within the last few years, you already have a partial profile on the website. In fact, you can take full advantage of the database by logging in through the Wild Apricot member portal at [pbkaca.wildapricot.org](http://pbkaca.wildapricot.org).

Using the online system helps everyone. You save time because you don't have to write checks, take letters to the post office, or wait for a receipt. PBKACA saves a considerable amount on postage, which means more money for programs, and it saves volunteer time that can be used to further the organization's goals.
